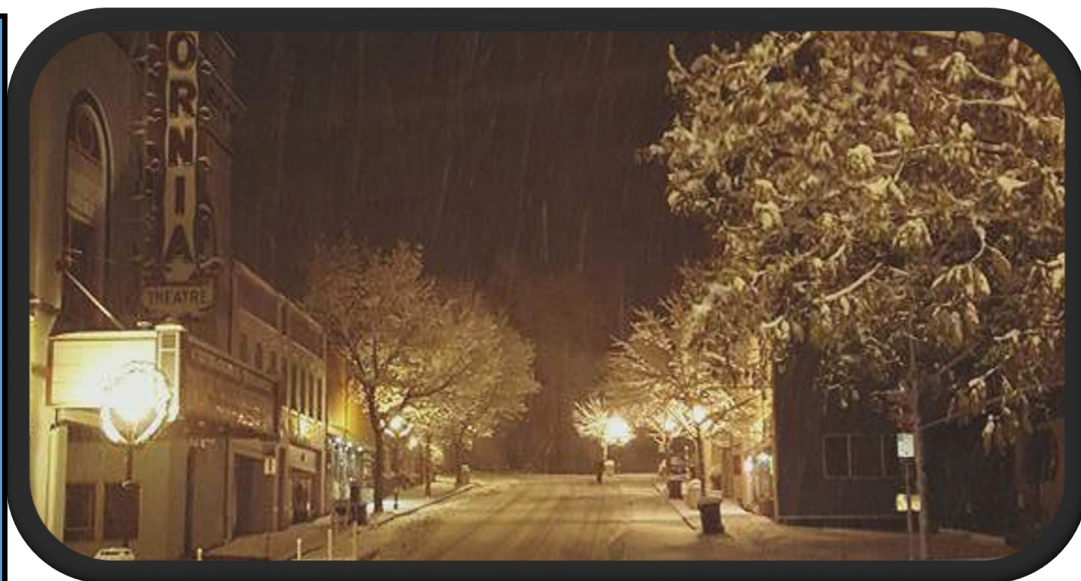

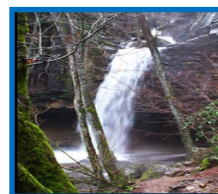
### *President's Message*
